

PhD Position in Poultry Vaccinology

Tasks

The PhD researcher will perform research in poultry parasitology/vaccinology. The focus is on the development of protection strategies against histomonosis by vaccination. Combining modern laboratory techniques with animal trials are the main focus of the project.

Graduation in Veterinary Medicine or other disciplines relevant to the research topic. Demonstration of skills gained during practical stays or other engagements should be supplied to support the application. The candidate should demonstrate the ability and willingness to work in an interdisciplinary and international environment. A fluent knowledge of the English language is required. Additional language skills in German are an additional asset.
