

Established in 1969, University of Prishtina is a public higher education institution that offers courses and programs leading to officially recognized higher education degrees such as bachelor degrees, master degrees, doctorate degrees in several areas of study.

- Annually, 530 get enrolled in all programs of study

 - In 2016, 11 in veterinary medicine, 127 Bsc dhe 35 Msc,
