

Internship, BSc, MSc or Diploma

Study: The effect of providing virtual friends on behaviour of domestic chickens

Duration: 1-2 weeks (internship), until summer 2023 (thesis)

Task: test room setup and disassembling, behaviour tests (1-2 weeks), video coding (1 week). For a degree also statistical analysis should be performed (depends on the experience).

When: as arranged

What do you need: University can provide all the equipment but having your own computer would be preferable. In case you have no own computer, you may use a university's computer.

Description

Animals experience stress when separated from companions. A student is needed to perform a study to identify the effect of having virtual social companions or mirror reduces separation stress and improves welfare. Domestic chickens will be used as a model. The study can be performed either at the campus or on a commercial farm. We will assess chicken behaviour (stress vocalisations and latency to feed) in three conditions: (1) alone in the test arena, (2) with a video of hens feeding, (3) with a mirror. The student will also develop a novel way of tracking faecal samples to individual animals without additional observation and handling.
