Sow and piglet dimensions


Behaviour - eg where do the sows defaecate



Step 1

- + 2013
- + slurry container
- + diffuse ventilation
- →'Few' pens

Pigproducer:

- + 'Damage-control'
- + The pigproducer tries out himself
- + Sows don't farrow in the same type of pen at each farrowing
- ÷ Sows are (may be) in crates for the rest of the production cycle
- + It doesn't become a routine to manage the pens
- + It's difficult to obtain a optimal climatic conditions






Step 2

→Large scale

Pigproducer:

- + All sows are loose at all times
- + Optimize management in relation to pen design
- + Possible to estimate/evaluate use of resources and potential for production
- + Possible to evaluate the economy
- ÷ Significant risk
- ÷ Can't change design easily afterwards - need to be 'right' first on
- **÷** Expensive
- ÷ So far, there is no premium for the porc

10 pct. in 10 years - how do we get there?






Transition proces
