

The Faculty of Agricultural Sciences of the Georg-August-University Goettingen invites applications for the position of a

W2 Professorship in “Animal Hygiene“ (all genders welcome)

which is to be filled at the earliest date possible.

The research focus of the professorship is in the areas of animal health and health risk for humans in a growing global population, increasing concentration of animal production and ongoing climate change. Important areas are microbiology and parasitology, epidemiology and diagnosis of animal diseases and zoonoses in temperate and tropical regions, host-pathogen-interactions and resistance for antibiotics as well as hygiene and quality of animal products.

We are seeking an outstanding personality, preferably a veterinarian with a visibility in international research literature in one or several of the topics mentioned above in accordance with the career stage and appropriate teaching experience. The successful candidate is expected to cover the entire discipline in the context of livestock and the One-health concept and to contribute to the faculty's research area of “*sustainable productivity, food security and quality*” in particular. The willingness to contribute to collaborative research projects within the faculty as well as with other faculties of Goettingen University and members of the Goettingen Campus is of high importance. A cooperation with the German Primate Center (DPZ) is planned. In teaching, the professorship will be involved in the study programs Agricultural Sciences (BSc. and MSc.), Sustainable International Agriculture, Integrated Plant and Animal Breeding, and Equine Sciences as well as in the doctorate / PhD programs. For non-German speakers, the willingness to learn German and to teach in German is expected after appropriate time. Innovative teaching concepts are welcome. The University of Goettingen places emphasis on research-oriented teaching.

Legal requirements for the position are according to §25 of Niedersächsisches Hochschulgesetz in its currently valid version. The University of Goettingen holds the right of appeal. Details will be illustrated upon request.

Applications of scientists from abroad are explicitly welcome. If equally qualified, severely handicapped persons are given preference. The University of Goettingen is an equal opportunity employer and places particular emphasis on fostering career opportunities for women. Qualified women are therefore strongly encouraged to apply. The University defines itself as family-friendly institution and supports the reconcilability of family and science/working life.

Candidates are invited to send their application containing the usual documents (such as curriculum vitae, scientific background inclusive teaching experience, publication list and a brief research perspective) until October 31th 2019 to the Dean
