Minimum salary

The minimum salary for university staff is regulated by the collective contract and at the level given above amounts EUR 3.945,90 (40 hours/week), EUR 3.354,- (34 hours/week) gross per month (14 times/year). The minimum salary may be increased when previous employment and other salary components are taken into account.
