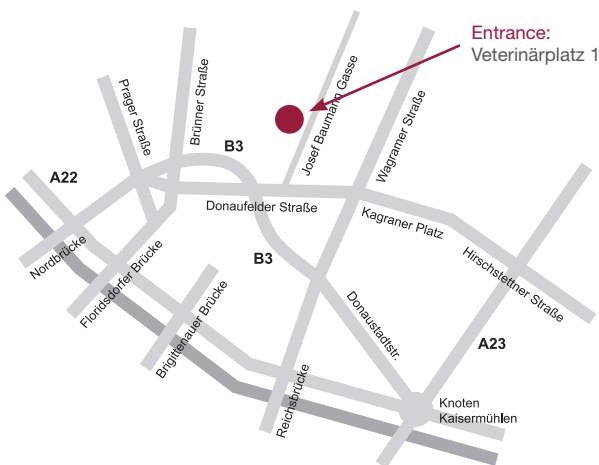

Service Centre for Researchers

From the West – Salzburg, Linz, St. Pölten:

A1 to the Knoten Steinhäusl interchange; A21 towards Wien Süd/Graz to the Knoten Vösendorf interchange; A2 and A23 towards Gänserndorf to the Hirschstetten exit; then follow map.

From the South – Villach, Klagenfurt, Graz:

A2 and A23 towards Gänserndorf to the Hirschstetten exit; then follow map.

From the North/Northwest – Tulln, Stockerau:

A22, take the Floridsdorfer Brücke exit, then follow map.

From the East – Schwechat, Hainburg:

highway A4 (Ostautobahn), then A23 towards Gänserndorf to the Hirschstetten exit; then follow map.

- Increasing collaboration between industry and the Vetmeduni Vienna

Support for Researchers

- Through informational events about current research support topics
- Via online information about current stipends and funding opportunities through research promotion programmes
- By providing application forms and relevant information
- Assistance with applications (project budget planning, specific requirements of the funding institution)
- Advice in drafting collaboration and consortium agreements
- Via grant management of research projects

Support with Technology Transfer

In addition to being leveraged for scientific purposes, innovative ideas from researchers and scientists ought to be successfully exploited in commercial applications. The Office for Research Support and Innovation (FFI) brings about alliances between partners from industry and science and...

- provides information about possible alliances at informational events and personal counselling sessions
- assists in the search for collaboration and commercial partners, and also in the professional execution of the partnership
- assesses possible discoveries with regard to their market potential and patentability
- guides and coordinates the entire development process
- takes an advisory role in contract negotiations
- supplies sample contracts as a basis for contract negotiations, e.g., Material Transfer Agreements (MTAs), Confidential Disclosure Agreements (CDAs) and for research and development (R&D) alliances
